

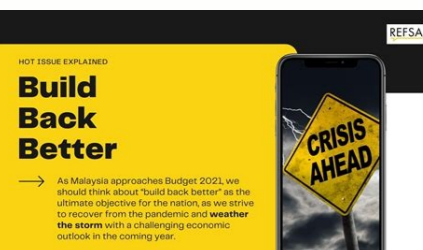

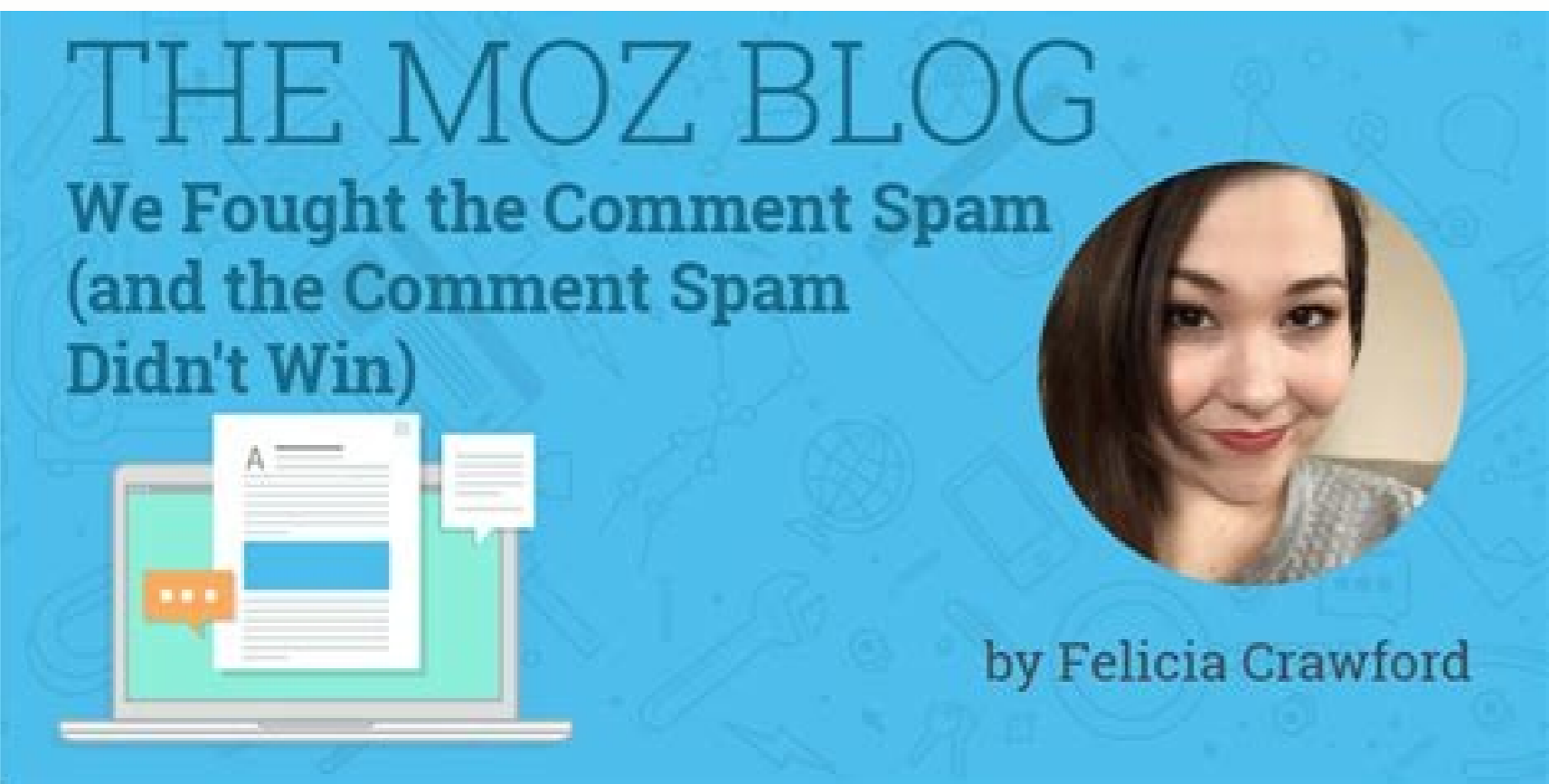
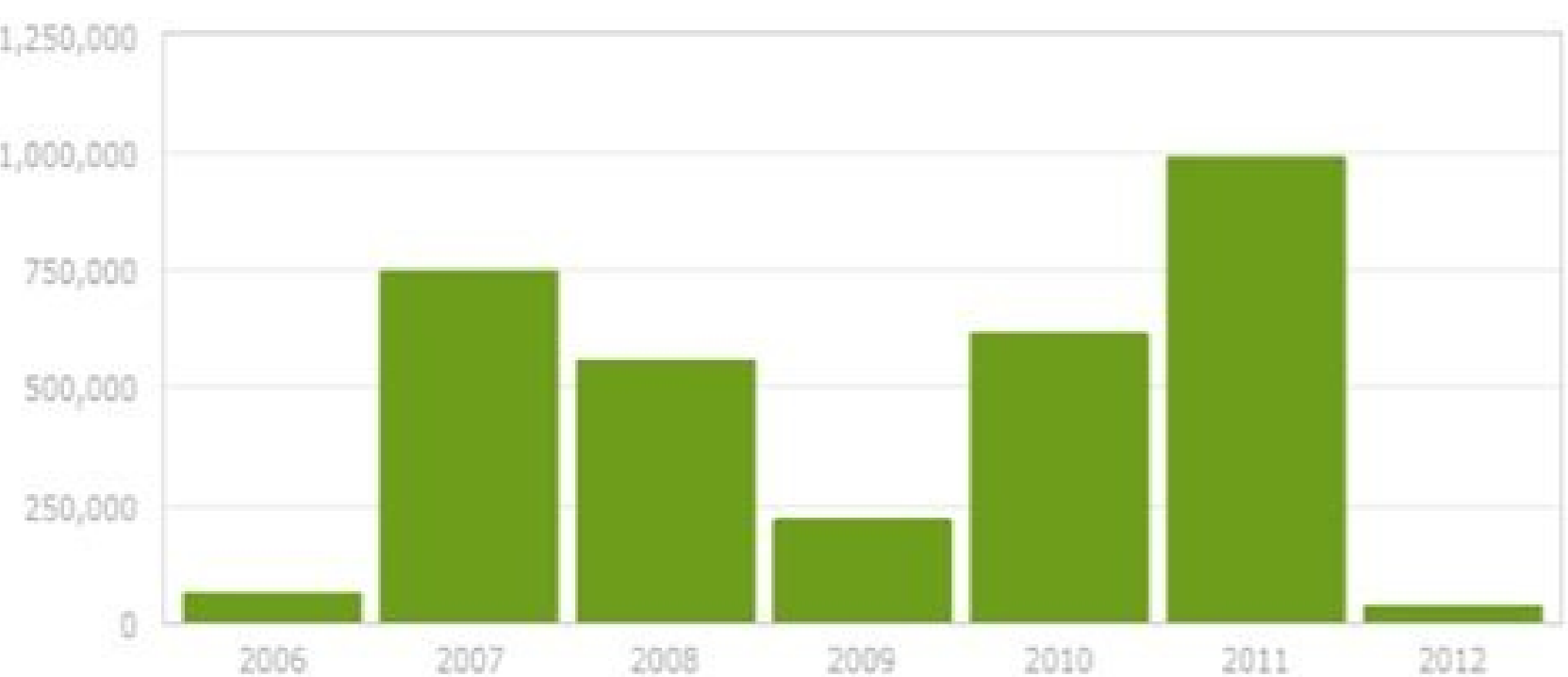


percentage of total missed spam reports
